

Part One: Mon 2nd Aug to Fri 6th Aug

Looking at all the basics of our faith - What does the Church teach? Why does it teach it? Why do we have the Bible? What is the Trinity? How does Mary fit into everything? What is salvation all about? These and many other topics will be covered during these days.

If you have not had much formation beyond Confirmation this is essential.

If you are not joining us for Part One but wish to book onto either / both of the second two parts we ask that you have done an Apologetics course (or equivalent) in the past covering such essentials as the teaching authority of the Church (the relationship between Scripture, Tradition and the Magisterium).

Part Two: Fri 6th Aug to Sun 8th Aug

Caroline Farey and Fr Austin will be exploring the topic of the Incarnation (Christ becoming man) and the Cross as well as a session looking at the new translation of the Mass.

Part Three: Sun 8th Aug to Wed 11th Aug

In the final part of the course we will be exploring the sacraments, Theology of the Body and other moral and social teaching of the Church.

This will be an amazing opportunity to ground yourselves more deeply in the reality of your faith. The course will include times for community and personal prayer so that the teachings will be experienced in a place of encounter with God.
