S.E.N.T. is a fully equipped residential Christian Conference Centre, available for hire. It can comfortably accommodate and cater for small and medium sized groups.

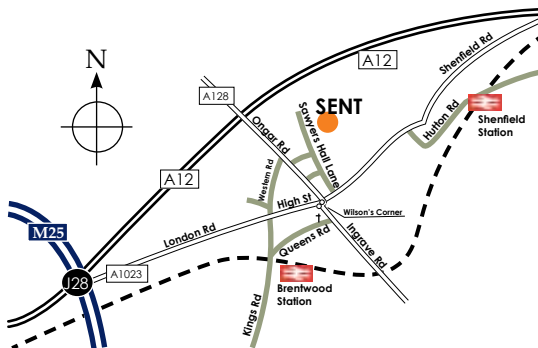

Directions to S.E.N.T.

By Car - Leave the M25 at Junction 28 and follow the signs for the A1023 towards Brentwood. Sion Community (S.E.N.T) is situated 3 miles from the motorway exit.

By Rail - The nearest train stations are Brentwood or Shenfield. The train stations are 1 mile away from the community house or 25-30min walk. There are taxis outside both stations.

By Air - London Stansted is the closest airport to our centre. There are trains into London but no direct bus connection to Brentwood.
